SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS

Dearborn County, Indiana
Date: February 15 & 16, 2010
Time: 09:29 am

AUTHORITY

Whereas, Dearborn County, Indiana has been hit by heavy snow and a wintery mix of precipitation on February 15, 2010. All roads in Dearborn County have become hazardous.

Now, therefore, we the Dearborn County Board of Commissioners, declare a Level Two Snow Emergency. (State Level II Snow Emergency), on this 15th. day of February, 2010 at 9.29 am.

A Level Two Snow Emergency states roadway conditions have become dangerous to routine traffic, with accumulated debris, and/or blowing and drifting snow. Icing may take place by means of freezing rain, sleet, or packed snow. Only travel that is necessary should be attempted. Employees should contact their employer to see if they should report to work.

Now, therefore, we the Dearborn County Board of Commissioners, declare a Level Three Snow Emergency on this 15th. day of February, 2010 at 7:00 pm “until at least” 7:00 am Tuesday, February 16, 2010 (State Level I Snow Advisory).

A Level Three Snow Emergency states the roadways are closed to all non-emergency traffic. Driving is prohibited unless it is due to an emergency and should be limited to essential personnel only. Those traveling may be subject to citation by law enforcement personnel. (State Level 1 Snow Emergency).

Now, therefore, we the Dearborn County Board of Commissioners, declare a Level Two Snow Emergency on this 16th. day of February, 2010 at 7:00 a.m.. (State Level II Snow Emergency)

A Level Two Snow Emergency states roadway conditions have become dangerous to routine traffic, with accumulated debris, and/or blowing and drifting snow. Icing may take place by means of freezing rain, sleet, or packed snow. Only travel that is necessary should be attempted. Employees should contact their employer to see if they should report to work.

Now, therefore, we the Dearborn County Board of Commissioners, declare we are no longer under a snow emergency/travel advisory, and have lifted our Level Two Snow Emergency effective at 4:30 p.m. today, February 17, 2010.
