SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS

Dearborn County, Indiana
Date/time: Feb.5, 2010 7:56 p.m.
Feb. 6, 2010 6:00 p.m.

AUTHORITY

Whereas, Dearborn County, Indiana has been hit by heavy snow and wintry mix of precipitation on February 5, 2010. All roads in Dearborn County have become hazardous.

Now, therefore, we the Dearborn County Board of Commissioners, declare a Level Two Snow Emergency on this 5th day of February, 2010 at 7:56 p.m..

A Level Two Snow Emergency states roadway conditions have become dangerous to routine traffic, with accumulated debris, and/or blowing and drifting snow. Icing may take place by means of freezing rain, sleet, or packed snow. Only travel that is necessary should be attempted. Employees should contact their employers to see if they should report to work.

Now, therefore, we the Dearborn County board of Commissioners, declare a Level Three Snow Emergency on this 6th day of February, 2010 at 4:57 a.m.

A Level Three Snow Emergency states all roadways are closed to all non-emergency traffic. Driving is prohibited unless it is due to an emergency and should be limited to essential personnel only. Those traveling on closed roadways for other than emergency or essential travel may be subject to citation by law enforcement personnel.

Now, therefore, we the Dearborn County Board of Commissioners, have downgraded/changed the Level Three Snow Emergency to a Level Two Snow Emergency this 6th day of February, 2010 at 1:00 p.m.

Now, therefore, we the Dearborn County Board of Commissioners, have downgraded from a Level Two Snow Emergency to a Level One Snow Emergency on this 6th day of February, 2010 at 6:00 p.m.
